VIPA Will Temporarily Close Enighed Gravel Parking Lot for Repairs



The parking lot adjacent to the Theovald E. Moorhead Dock and Terminal at Enighed Pond, St. John will be closed for 10 days starting **Monday, August 12, 2019**. The parking lot, which is owned by the Virgin Islands Port Authority, will be closed as a safety precaution while VIPA's contractor renovates the lot - including replacing the gravel and repairing the surrounding fence. The lot should be reopened by Thursday, August 22, 2019.

Free parking is available at VIPA's parking lot at the Victor W. Sewer Marine Facility in Cruz Bay. VIPA apologizes for the inconvenience and thanks the public for their patience as the Authority improves its facilities.
