The Virgin Islands Port Authority was notified that Royal Caribbean Cruise Line's Harmony of the Seas cruise ship has canceled its visit to the Austin "Babe" Monsanto Marine Terminal in Crown Bay, St. Thomas VI, on Wednesday, September 4, 2019. The visit was canceled due to inclement weather at their homeport caused by Hurricane Dorian.
