## **Port Authority to Fine Partiers for Failure to Clean Up After Parties at Lindbergh Bay Beach**

Failure to remove your trash after partying at Lindbergh Bay Beach could result in fines issued to permit holders, announced Virgin Islands Port Authority Executive Director Kenn Hobson.

Hobson said that, effective immediately, the Port Authority will begin to fine individuals or groups who have obtained a permit from the Department of Housing Parks and Recreation to host an event at the Lindbergh Bay Beach and do not comply with garbage removal requirements immediately after the function. He reminds the public that all trash is to be picked up from the beach and roadside, and the garbage (including bags, boxes, bottles, etc.) is to be hauled by the event owner off of the beach to a dump site. Hobson said that there is also signage on Lindbergh Bay Beach that lists the rules and regulations for usage of the beach.

Hobson added that he encourages the Virgin Islands community to help keep Lindbergh Bay Beach and areas along the Cyril E. King Airport access road clean and presentable for the enjoyment of locals as well as visitors to our islands.
