## VIRGIN ISLANDS PORT AUTHORITY MARINE TARIFF AMENDMENTS

The Virgin Islands Port Authority will host a public meeting to discuss changes to its marine tariff on **August 30th at 6 p.m.** in the conference room on the third floor of the VIPA Administrative Building on St. Thomas.

The meeting will be available via teleconference at the Port Authority's conference room on the second floor of the Henry E. Rohlsen Airport Terminal on St. Croix, and at the Cleone H. Creque-Maynard Legislative Conference Room on St. John.

### **PUBLIC HEARING AGENDA:**

- **The elimination of the water tour operators fee** effective March 1, 2017;
- **The elimination of the \$0.25 St. Thomas/St. John passenger fee** which has never been charged to travelers; and
- **The amended marine facility pre-paid/pre-arranged taxi tour vehicle fee** of \$7 per trip or \$13 per day.

The public and the media are invited to attend these meetings. VIPA officials will present the proposed tariff increases, provide details about planned improvements for the territory's seaports, and address any public concerns regarding the changes to VIPA's fees.
